In the month of August the Zamora Road Runners changed the lives of 8 Children.


In July Zamora provided five van trips. Two trips were made to the Cincinnati Shrine Hospital.

RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO ZAMORA BYLAWS FROM THE RECORDER'S DESK

AT THE STATED MEETING ON NOVEMBER 9, 2016 THE RECORDER WILL BE READING THE RECOMMENDED CHANGE TO THE ZAMORA BYLAWS. THESE CHANGES WERE READ AT THE JULY 21, 2016 STATED MEETING. THERE WERE OTHER RECOMMENDED CHANGES MADE BY THE RECORDER. AFTER SOME DISCUSSION A MOTION WAS MADE FOR THE RECORDER TO DROP ALL PROPOSAL EXCEPT THE CHANGE PERTAINING TO LIFE MEMBERSHIP. A MOTION WAS MADE AND SECOND FOR THE CHANGES TO BE TABLE UNTIL THE NOVEMBER STATED MEETING AT WHICH TIME THE RECORDER WOULD READ THE RECOMMENDED CHANGE TO LIFE MEMBERSHIP.

THE CURRENT BYLAWS READS AS FOLLOW:

2.7 Life Membership. Life memberships in this temple are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International.

Amended to read:

- (1) All members who are sixty-five (65) years of age and who have paid dues for a term of thirty-five (35) consecutive year shall become life members within the Zamora Shrine Temple without payment of any fee other than the Shrine International per capita and Shrine Hospital assessment fee.
- (2) The Potentate shall automatically become a life member upon completion of his term in office. He will still be required to pay the Hospital Assessment Tax and the Per Capita Tax.
- (3) All others Zamora Shriners that does not qualify in accordance with one of the paragraph above may purchase a Life Membership (332.6(a)(3), Life Per Capita Tax (211.5(g) and/or a Permanent Contributing Membership in the Hospitals (332.4(a) in accordance with the Shriners International Bylaws paragraphs
