**Special Notes:** Bring a folding chair with you and plenty of sunscreen and bug repellent.

**Fishing Rodeo:** The fishing rodeo is open to all children 18 and under. The participants will be required to bring their own bait and fishing equipment. Bob Starr has agreed to be the registrar and judge. The Zamora Director Staff has agreed to furnish trophies and prizes for the winners. This event kicks off at 8:00 am and judging will start at 12:00 pm. Registration and judging will take place under the pop up tent that will be near the pier.

**Widows Sons Gathering:** The Widows Sons will meet at the end of the road on the far side of the lake at 10:00 am. A group photo will be made with the riders and their bikes overlooking the lake.

**Recruiting stations:** The different bodies will have the opportunity to set up recruiting stations in the pavilion on the hill from 1:30 pm till 4:00 pm. We will not have facilities to make copies so be sure to bring extra copies of all supplies.

**Archery by the lake:** There will be three hay bales set up with targets and three sets of recurve bows will be provided. Each child 18 and under who participates will be allowed three shots to obtain their score. There will be three winners as follows: Best Score age 0 -8, Best Score age 9-14, Best Score age 15-18. There will also be a shoot off between the heads of each of the bodies present. The winner will receive a special trophy and bragging rights.

**Pool Privileges:** The pool will be open with no charge on this date.

**Car/Motorcycle/Dune Buggy Show:** There will be a car show in the open field across from the pool house. We DO NOT WANT rides for the people present - simply park your ride and bring a bucket to collect tickets. The tickets will be given to children as they enter the park and they will have an opportunity to vote on their favorite ride. If it has wheels, it is eligible for the contest, just bring your own bucket for tickets. There will be a trophy for the winner. The children will be allowed to vote from 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm.

**Childrens coloring contest:** Each child (age 0-13) who participates will be given a box of crayons and a blank piece of paper and will create what they feel best represents a Shriner. There will be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophy for this contest. It will take place during the vote for best of show 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm.

**Clown Competition:** Will take place from 6:00-6:30 pm on the patio behind the Club House next to the pool. There will be prizes for the following categories: White Face, Auguste Clown, Hobo, Best Overall, Balloon Competition. To compete in Best Overall you must have a skit. You must supply your own balloons.

**Gospel Singing:** Ed Mason will be out with his gospel group and will start singing at 8:00 pm. They will setup at the pavilion at the top of the hill.

# Recorder's Notebook: Mentoring is a two-way street

Read the information – then click “sign up now”.

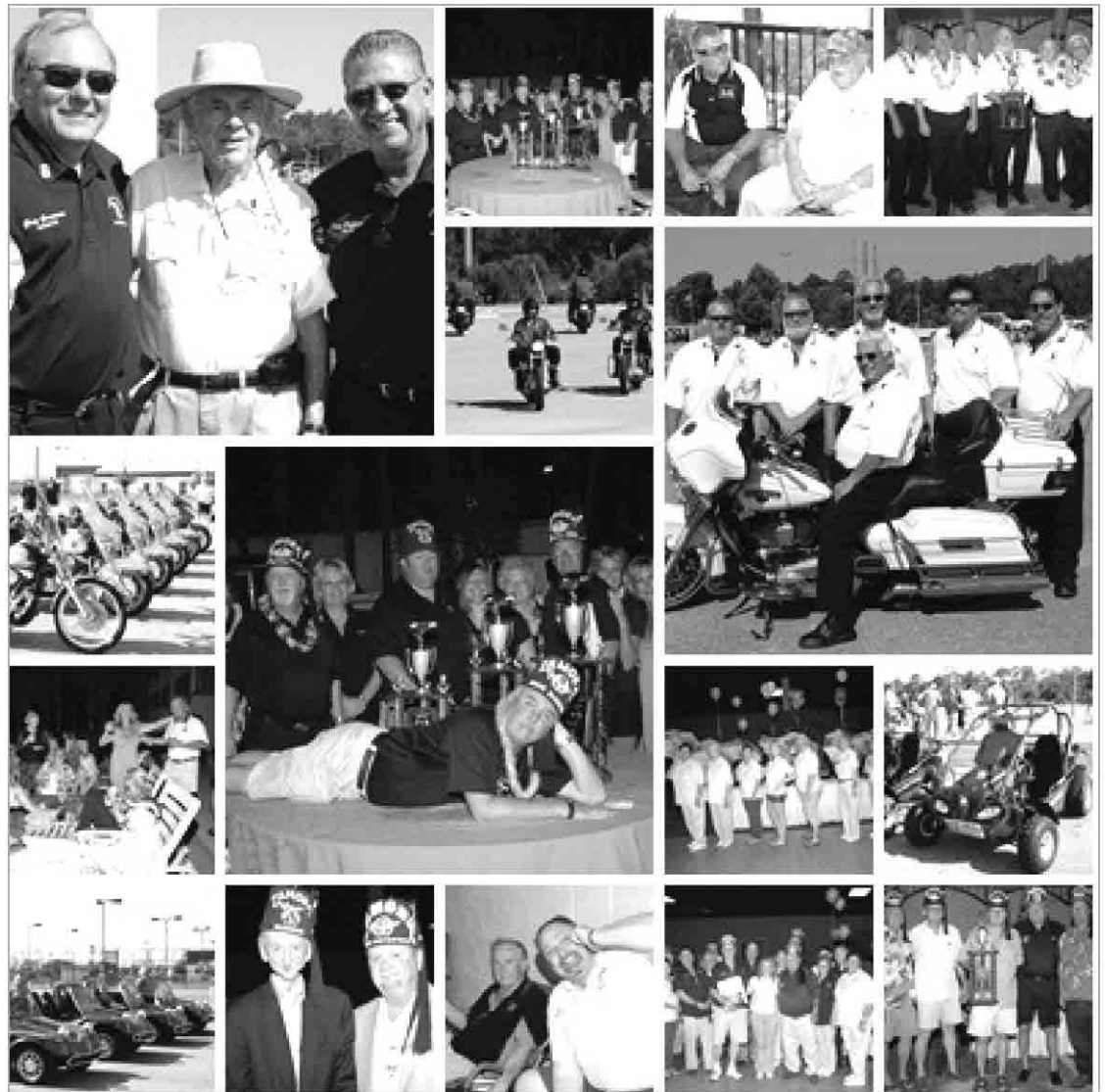
