For a brother will not be a brother, if he feels unwelcome and alone.






























Making a difference great New Year's resolution for Shriners



News from Cincinnati

Road Runners Transport Precious Cargo



Every Shriners temple has a special unit of transporters called the Road Runners. Countless miles and innumerable hours have been accumulated by this unique group of volunteers. The Road Runners have all traveled millions of roads and highways transporting children and their families to Shriners Hospitals for Children® across the United States then safely home again. When asked why they volunteer so much of their time, the Road Runners simply reply that when they see what our patients and families are going through, they are honored to "go the distance" and feel privileged to take on the tasks assigned to this unit.

When visiting or working at Shriners Hospitals for Children – Cincinnati, you are likely to run into one, two or more of our volunteer drivers. "I started driving in 1988" said Road Runner Marvin Boyer of Syrian Shriners. "Back then, we used our own vehicles and gas and we operated out of the temple, not the hospital." Road Runner Bud Linn became involved with the Road Runners in 1992. "Over the years we gave talks, showed films, took people on tours, and picked up patients and families to bring to the hospital; really anything we could do to be helpful."


