## FROM YOUR RECORDER DON BAKER



The following is from SHRINERS INTERNATION-AL PROTOCOL revised August, 2013, as pertaining to Shrine Parade Regulations. Some of these items have been questioned by a few nobles recently. When lining up and waiting on the parade to start, we must always be aware of the public watching us and, therefore, we must present a good image.

Non-Shriners. Other than the police escort, dignitaries, distinguished guests and Shriners Hospitals for Children patients, only Shriners are permitted in Shrine parades.

Impersonations. No impersonations of ethnic groups, females, or political figures are allowed in parades.

Vehicle Equipment. No motorized vehicles shall engage their emergency sirens or lights.

Safety Laws. Motorcycles, scooters, and other motorized vehicles shall obey local laws regarding speed, prudent operation and the use of hard helmets. In states where helmets are not required, the Temple

Potentate may direct helmet use for safety reasons instead of fezzes.

Throwing Objects. Neither candy nor other objects shall be THROWN to spectators along the parade route. A Shriner may walk along the edge of the parade route and hand out candy, Shrine information or other appropriate objects. (No latex balloons.)

Alcoholic Beverages. Members of participating Units shall not drink any alcoholic beverages before or during any parade, and they shall be circumspect in the use of soft drinks in public places so as not to give the impression they are drinking alcoholic beverages.

Shriners Only. Notwithstanding the provisions in paragraph 335.11 of the International bylaws, in parades of Temples at annual sessions of Shriners International, or in local Shrines' parades of exhibitions under the auspices of Temples or Shrine associations, only Nobles shall participate.

Civic Parades. In civic

parades, and non-Shrine public appearances, Nobles, their Ladies and children, and Masonic relation of sponsored organizations, may participate, with the approval of the Potentate.

Only Nobles may perform,

compete, ride vehicles with fewer than four wheels, or operate any vehicle while parading.



#### Mitte named Love to the rescue ambassador

Mitte will use his story of receiving treatment for cerebral palsy at Shriners Hospitals for Children to help other families learn more about the care available and to encourage public support of the organization.

(TAMPA, Florida) Shriners Hospitals for Children® is pleased to announce former patient and award-winning actor RJ Mitte as a national to the rescue Ambassador<sup>TM</sup> for their 2014 Love to the rescue® campaign. Mitte will share his personal story of receiving both treatment for cerebral palsy and encouragement to accept no limits to living with a disability through a series of Public Service Announcements and other appearances through the year.

This February, RJ Mitte invited the public to join him and send their Love to the rescue of the children by making a donation to Shriners Hospitals for Children at lovetotherescue.org. Supporters also posted Valentine's Day notes to the Wall of Love that were shared with the patients at Shriners Hospitals for Children.

At the age of 3, Mitte was diagnosed with cerebral palsy, a neurological condition affecting muscle tone, movement and coordination. He was to the Shriners referred Hospital for Children in Shreveport, LA, when he was noticed walking on his toes. To correct his walking, the orthopaedic experts at Shriners Hospitals for Children recommended a casting procedure instead of an invasive surgery, which had been recommended by other doctors. Mitte was treated by the medical experts and physical therapy specialists at Shriners Hospitals for Children for most of his childhood and, as a result, overcame many of the physical and verbal effects of cerebral palsy.

"I can't thank Shriners Hospitals for Children enough for what they did to help me overcome the effects of cerebral palsy. Had it not been for my doctors and therapists, I would not be walking and talking as well as I am today, "said Mitte. "I know firsthand that Shriners Hospitals for Children is a special place where kids are given a life of possibilities because they send Love to the rescue every day."

Mitte recently visited Shriners Hospitals for Children — Los Angeles to meet patients and to talk about the bond and support shared between children living with disabilities.

"We are honored to help RJ share his story so others living with disabilities see that there really are endless possibilities to what they can achieve," said John Cinotto, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Shriners Hospitals for Children. "Every day Shriners Hospitals for Children sends Love to the rescue by encouraging patients to accept no limits throughout their treatment process. Working with RJ will help us highlight the innovative pediatric care available at Shriners Hospitals for Children."

#### **About RJ Mitte**

RJ Mitte is an actor best known for his role as Walter "Flynn" White Jr. on the AMC series *Breaking Bad*. The show was awarded Best Drama at the 2014 Golden Globes and the 2014 SAG Award for Best Ensemble.

After moving to Hollywood in 2006, Mitte began his acting career with several appearances as an extra on the *Hannah Montana Show*, 7th Heaven and Weeds. Mitte is currently appearing on ABC Family's Switched at Birth, where he is the new love interest for the series lead.

### Becoming Shriner was a proud moment for Hall

Moorhead, Ky., became a member of El Hasa Shriners in March of 2011, it was a moment he had been looking forward to for many years.

"Shriners are great people to be around because they want to help children and have fun," said Taylor. "I couldn't wait to become one of them."

Taylor was born with spina bifida, a condition that involves the incomplete development of the spinal cord or its coverings. Taylor has been a patient at Shriners Hospitals for Children® — Lexington since he was 3 months old.
