
There will be 3 fast entry lines when you come in the park (by the airplane)

Notice to all the Nobles of Zamora we are starting a new phone calling system



The Zamora Spring Ceremonial class named for Illustrious Sir Wm Gene Thompson, P.P.

In 1960, the Illustrious Sir Wm Gene Thompson was honorably discharged and completed his active service in the Air Force and moved to Birmingham, Alabama at the invitation of an uncle who worked at Baggett Transportation Company. His uncle helped him go to work in the Parts Department at Baggett and he started his life as a civilian. He soon met his future wife, Pat, and they were married in April of 1962. They were blessed with two children, Paige and Rusty. Gene had entered the Air Force directly after high school graduation in Rockingham, North Carolina. After he settled in Birmingham, he started night classes at Samford University and while working during the daytime and classes at night, he graduated from Samford University in 1968. After getting his degree in Business, he started work at New York Life Insurance Company and continued there until he retired.

In March of 1971, Illustrious Sir Gene Thompson became a Mason at the Gardendale Lodge. He immediately went through the York Rite and joined Zamora Temple during the Fall Class of 1971. The Dune Buggy Unit had just been formed and Noble Thompson joined the unit and started driving on the drill team. After a couple of years, the unit members bought the new dune buggies and started to participate in motor corps competition. His apricot buggy was one of the first four buggies delivered to Birmingham from the builder in Daytona, Florida. The next several years were dominated by competitions at Dixie, Southeastern, and Imperial conventions. Almost all of the weekends were usually spent practicing the drill or working on the buggies.

In 1980, Illustrious Sir Potentate Don Hart started a group known as the Potentate's Staff. Gene was asked to join the group and he did although he still remained on the Dune Buggy Drill Team. In 1981, Illustrious Sir Potentate Larry Allred appointed him to be Chief of Potentate's Staff and he accepted the appointment and remained in that position until he was appointed to the Divan in 1990 by Illustrious Sir Potentate Gene Lanier. He advanced on the Divan and was elected Potentate in 1997.

Illustrious Sir Gene Thompson has always been an active Shriner and received Top Shriner Awards in 1980, 1981, 1982, 1984 and awards for Paper Sales and Fund Raising in 1994 and 1995. He was named Shriner of the Year in 1980.

After his year serving as Potentate, he took a brief recess of a couple of years which enabled him to spend more time with his family and grandchildren, Travis and Logan. Once they had outgrown him, he joined the Greeters Unit and has once again become active in Zamora Temple. He served as Director of the Greeters in 2015 and enjoys the fellowship and opportunity for service to the Temple and the Shrine charities.
